Since the founding of the Unitarian Church of All Souls in 1819, women have played an active role in the congregation. Today the Women's Alliance (WA) is a community of more than 120 women who embody Unitarian Universalist values in their lives. Most are members of All Souls; however, non-church members are very welcome.

We aim to cultivate an environment in which women of all ages can participate in social, cultural, educational and charitable activities designed to enrich their lives. Frequent small group outings, as well as monthly meetings, create an atmosphere where new friendships can be forged.

The Women's Alliance is recognized by the IRS as a charitable organization. Tax-deductible contributions are welcomed.

Activities

Monthly Meetings: Gathering monthly from October through May, members enjoy time to socialize and a brief business meeting, along with a speaker or other program. Members bring a brown bag lunch; we provide dessert and drinks.

Outings: Excursions to museums, local landmarks, recreation sites and parks provide opportunities for small group interaction, and often include an optional meal at a nearby restaurant.

Special Interest Groups (SIGs): These groups address the varied interests of WA members. For example, we have a Cinema Club, a Music Group and a Women's Reading Group, among others. Any member can initiate a new SIG if she is willing to serve as Coordinator.

Special Events: Our special WA events include:

- A Welcome Back Party in the fall
- The Holiday Party in December
- The Annual Angie Utt Lecture on "Women in American Culture" in the winter
- The Spring Event, a presentation by a noted speaker on an issue critical to women.

Charitable Works. The WA undertakes fundraising activities, with the monies generated given to charities. Members are also encouraged to volunteer their services at All Souls' Monday Night Hospitality and Friday Soup Kitchen meal programs, as well as other social justice initiatives.
